1. Island Yacht Club is a seasonal club which operates annually from mid-May to mid-October with no access to the clubhouse or amenities between mid-October and mid-May.
2. Cambridge Group of Club members are offered the full use of IYC’s Club Facilities, including the Clubhouse, Pool Bar & Grill (open July and August on Friday’s, Saturday’s, Sunday’s and Holiday Monday’s), the pool (when weather permits for opening), tennis & pickle ball courts (some restrictions may apply – please inquire with your Letter of Introduction), kayaks, canoes and SUP’s (available on a first come first use basis), as well as Tender service to and from the Island Yacht Club.
3. All reciprocal guests must be in good standing with their home Club to be granted reciprocal privileges. Membership cards must be presented upon arrival to the Island Yacht Club.
4. Reciprocal guests must abide by Island Yacht Club’s By-Laws, Rules & Regulations and Policies, which will be provided to guests with confirmation of their visit.
5. A Letter of Introduction, for each visit, must be provided by the Cambridge Group of Clubs a minimum of 48 hours in advance, but no more than seven (7) days in advance, of the requested visit date. Letters of Introduction are to be e-mailed to membership@iyc.ca.
6. Cambridge Group of Club members may visit the Island Yacht Club four (4) times per season, as per the below listed rates. CGoC members may bring guests to the IYC (maximum of 4 guests per visit), as per the below listed rates. The Island Yacht Club reserves the right to limit the number of guests they will accept on any given day.

8. Reservations must be made in advance by the CGoC member(s) and payment for visits shall be made by VISA, MasterCard or American Express upon arrival at the Island Yacht Club.
